The Horus Scope is a peripheral designed to work with the Amwell cart. It is intended to take digital photographs and video of the eye fundus, ears, and skin.

Horus Scope Connection to Amwell Cart

➤ Connect the mini USB end to the bottom of the Horus Scope handle or to the charging base.

NOTE: If there is a charging base, will need to plug the mini USB to the bottom of the Horus scope when using the device.

➤ On the other end of the charging cable, take the regular size USB and insert it into any USB port of the Amwell cart.

NOTE: If there are two USB plugs, plug in the USB with two wires connected to it. The single-wire USB will not allow video to be shared.

- Check if the UVC mode is enabled.
 - Tap the **camera** button in the top left corner of the touchscreen.
 - Tap the **menu** button that appears in the bottom left corner.
 - Tap the **UVC** button in the top right corner of the screen, will be **highlighted blue** once enabled.

Horus Scope Connection to Amwell Cart

- > On the **Amwell cart** tap the **Menu** button.
- Tap Devices.
 - The Horus scope will show as an available device.
- > Tap Share.
 - The video will show on the Amwell cart and the provider will be able to view the video.
 - Images cannot be saved at this time.
- Tap **End Share** to stop sharing the Horus scope's image.
