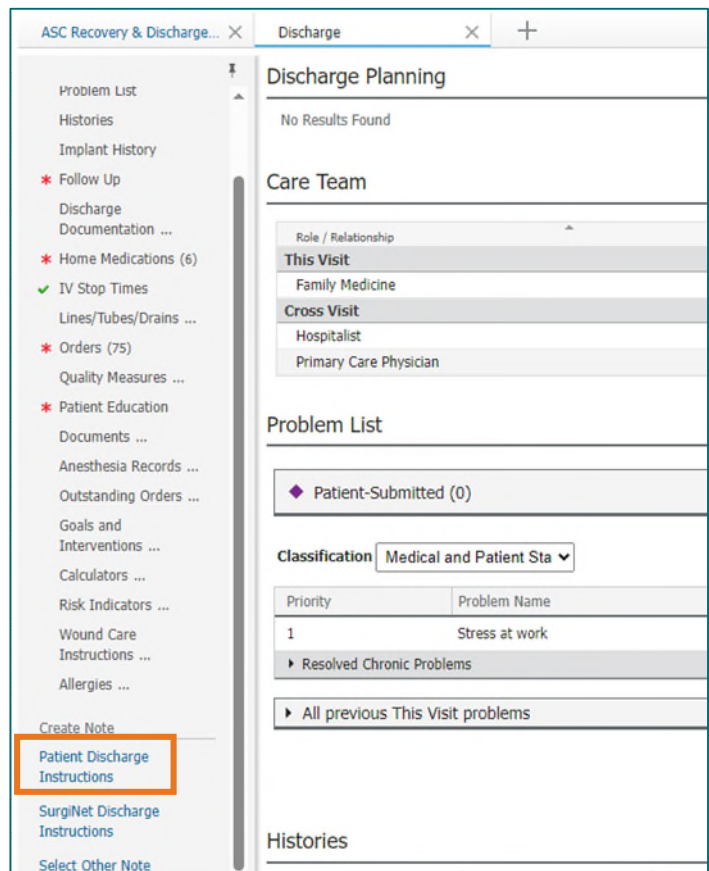
- Test Performed/Pending
