

ECG Order Reconciliation

WHEN: Tuesday, December 17, 2024

WHERE: The change will affect the following venue(s):

- Acute/Inpatient (to include ED & Peri-Op)
- Ambulatory

At the following NLH Member Organization(s):

WHO: The change will affect the following staff at the above noted locations:

WHAT: Active ECG orders will automatically cancel/DC 30 days after an encounter is discharged.

NOTE: Staff responsible for matching ECG studies will need to reconcile orders prior to January 14, 2025.

WHY: The volume of active ECG orders not matched to an ECG tracing have been causing slowness in Cerner.
