WHAT: Hyperbilirubinemia guidelines will be updated to remove the PediTools screening tool. The change will enable care teams to quickly assess the risk of hyperbilirubinemia, escalate treatment when appropriate, and access the latest treatment interventions and recommendations.

WHY: Current Hyperbilirubinemia guidelines within Cerner have been updated to be consistent with the most recent AAP Hyperbilirubinemia management guidelines released in late 2022. Due to this, PediTools will be removed.
