

# **Agitation Assessment: BH DASA**

## (Dynamic Appraisal of Situational Aggression)

## WHEN: Tuesday, November 19, 2024

#### WHERE: The change will affect the following venue(s):

- Emergency Department
- Acute/Inpatient

#### At the following NLH Member Organization(s):

• All NLH Organizations, excluding NL Mayo Hospital

#### WHO: The change will affect the following staff at the above noted locations:

- ED Nursing
- Inpatient Nursing
- Behavioral Health Clinicians
- WHAT: Patients presenting to the Emergency Department with a behavioral health complaint will be **assessed for risk of aggression** using the **BH DASA.** The DASA is an assessment tool that considers several factors like patient behavior, verbal cues, and environmental stressors to predict the likelihood of aggressive behavior within a brief period.
  - **WHY:** Documentation of agitation screening using the **BH DASA** will improve the handoff process between behavioral health providers and ED clinicians.

## **HOW: BH DASA iView Documentation**

- BH DASA will be available within the **ED Systems Assessment band**.
- Documentation will flow to other Inpatient Systems Assessment bands and will be available to inpatient nursing to review and complete as needed.
