



## ImageTrend EMS Runsheets Go-Live

**WHEN:** Monday, November 18, 2024

**WHERE:** The change will affect the following venue(s):

- ED Only

**At the following NLH Member Organization(s):**

- Northern Light Mercy Hospital

**WHO:** The change will affect the following staff at the above noted locations:

- ED Nurses
- ED Nurse Techs
- Unit Coordinators

**WHAT:** **ImageTrend**, a software platform used by **Emergency Medical Services**, enables EMS personnel to electronically document details about **patient care, treatment, and transport**. The documentation is part of an electronic patient care report (**ePCR**). Once signed, the ePCR will be sent **electronically** through direct messaging to **FirstNet Message Center**. **This will allow clinical staff to attach the documentation directly to the patient chart.**

**WHY:** The platform is designed to improve data accuracy and facilitate the sharing of patient information.

**HOW:** **Monitoring Results**

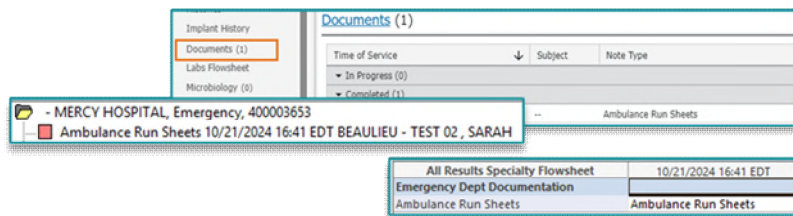
- Identified clinical staff will monitor the **Mercy EMS Runsheets Pool** in **FirstNet Message Center** and follow the patient match process for ePCRs.
- Once the Ambulance Runsheet is matched, an **icon** will appear within the **Patient Information** column on **ED LaunchPoint**.
