

## **CHANGE ATTENDING TO ME**

- A new relationship, CHANGE ATTENDING TO ME, will appear when opening all patient charts.
- Primary Care Physicians taking care of inpatients will use the CHANGE ATTENDING TO ME relationship when assuming care of the patient.



NOTE: If the CHANGE ATTENDING TO ME relationship is selected on a non-inpatient encounter, an Alert will notify the physician of the invalid relationship.



NOTE: Primary Care Physicians listed as a patient's PCP on an inpatient encounter will not receive the option "Change Attending to Me," as this relationship has been established as a lifetime PCP relationship. A Change Attending order will need to be placed to update the attending physician field.
