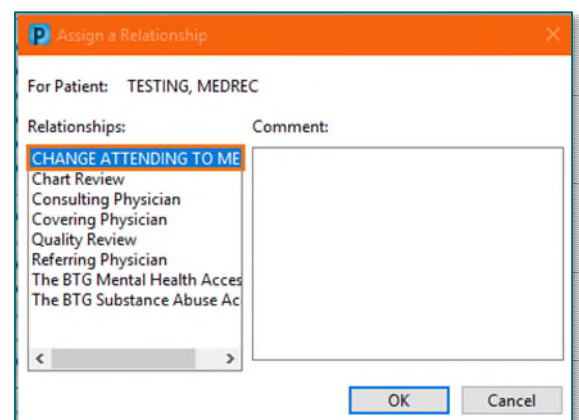

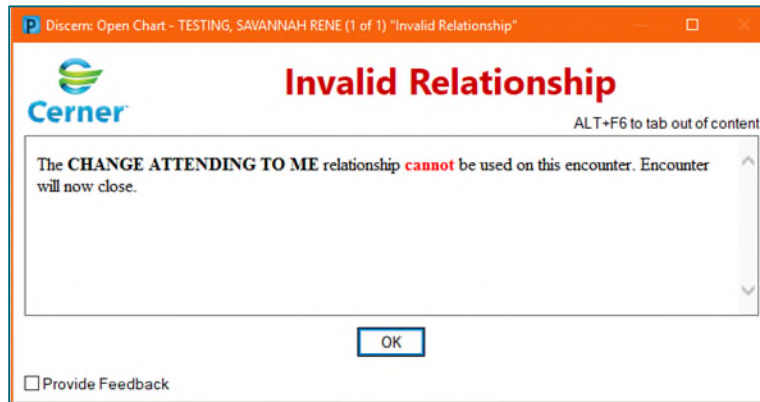
WHAT: New Visit Relationship

CHANGE ATTENDING TO ME

- A new relationship, **CHANGE ATTENDING TO ME**, will appear when opening all patient charts.
- Primary Care Physicians taking care of **inpatients** will use the **CHANGE ATTENDING TO ME** relationship when assuming care of the patient.



NOTE: If the **CHANGE ATTENDING TO ME relationship** is selected on a non-inpatient encounter, an **Alert** will notify the physician of the **invalid relationship**.



NOTE: Primary Care Physicians listed as a patient's PCP on an inpatient encounter **will not** receive the option "Change Attending to Me," as this relationship has been established as a lifetime PCP relationship. A **Change Attending** order will need to be placed to update the attending physician field.
