

BMDI Vital Signs Display in Interactive View I&O (iView)

WHEN: Effective Immediately

WHERE: The change will affect the following venue(s):

- Acute/Inpatient
- ED
- Peri-Op
- Outpatient Procedural Areas

At the following NLH Member Organization(s):

- All NLH Organizations (excluding NL Mayo)

WHO: The change will affect the following staff at the above noted locations:

- All staff using BMDI within iView.

WHAT: Recent iView updates from the code upgrade are affecting how results display within the EHR and now display the actual clinical time obtained via BMDI.

WHY: A correction package implemented as part of the code upgrade was required in preparation for future functionality. **With BMDI, continuous vital signs (i.e., pulse, respiratory rate) are recorded every 60 seconds and blood pressure is documented from the actual time taken.** This results in vital signs appearing in two separate columns within iView.

HOW: Staff will continue to use iView to review and document results, and sign data as displayed. Staff should **NOT** correct results to display in the same time column.

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
